

# People Praise Jesus as Their King

Bible story based on Luke 19:29-38; John 12:12-19



bring it here."






The disciples found the donkey where Jesus said it would be. They told the owners, "The Lord needs your donkey." The owners let them take it.








### About It

How did Juan and Isabella and Mr. de la Cruz praise Jesus? How do you praise Jesus? Let's do some of those things and praise Jesus together this week.





## Faith in Action
