
## Ready for Worship?



What does the condition of the temple tell you about the people's relationship with God?

When they had assembled their fellow Levites and consecrated themselves, they went in to purify the temple of the LORD, as the king had ordered, following the word of the LORD. The priests went into the sanctuary of the LORD to purify it. They brought out to the courtyard of the LORD's temple everything unclean that they found in the temple of the LORD.

Hezekiah opened the doors of the temple for worship. He also cleaned and repaired the temple. Then he

gathered together the priests and Levites.<sup>3</sup> Hezekiah knew that the priests needed to purify<sup>4</sup> the temple.
