




Joseph's brothers didn't like him. They sold him to people who took Joseph to Egypt to be a slave.



After Joseph grew up he worked for the pharaoh of Egypt. Joseph sold food to the people.




One day Joseph's brothers came to buy food. They did not recognize Joseph. When he told them who he was, they were afraid of him.



Talk About It


Bible Truth: God's Word tells me to forgive others when they hurt me.
